



# HAHNENKAMM RENNEN KITZBÜHEL

## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION (GCA) PAGE 1/2

- 1.) **Event Grounds:** The boundaries of the event grounds and spectator area are determined by an ordinance of the municipality of Kitzbühel.
- 2.) **Caution -Alpine Terrain:** The special conditions found in natural, winter terrain are challenging, therefore spectators should adapt their behaviour accordingly and ensure they are properly equipped. The main spectator area is located at the race finish area (ski slope). The racecourse itself is located in steep mountain terrain and only partially accessible on foot or with skis; applicable warning signs and safety barriers must be observed. **UNEVEN TERRAIN ON SNOW IN THE EVENT GROUNDS - SLIPPERY!**
- 3.) **Restricted Access:** Admission to the event grounds is only permitted with a valid admission permit (wristband, admission or special ticket, accreditation). These are not transferable. On entering the event grounds, attendees accept these GCA.
- 4.) **Safety Checks:** Stewards and security staff are authorized to search persons seeking admission to the event for dangerous objects, as well as the contents of any containers they might have brought with them. Security staff are authorized to deny admission to people who refuse body searches or attempt to bring dangerous objects into the event grounds. Those who appear to be under the influence of alcohol will also be denied admission for security reasons.
- 5.) **Food and Drinks:** Bringing food or drinks of any kind, especially alcoholic beverages, into the event grounds, is prohibited! Stewards and security staff are authorized to search spectators and their bags to ensure compliance with this ordinance and may refuse entry!
- 6.) **Advertising ban:** The unauthorized introduction of promotional materials of any kind (such as banners, prospectuses, newspapers and magazines etc.) is strictly forbidden. Fans may use advertising-free banners. These, however, must not hinder visibility or endanger the safety of others.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION (GCA) PAGE 2/2

- 7.) **Media Rights:** All sound, video and film recordings, regardless of their technical system (e.g. radio, film and TV recordings) may only be made and distributed by those in possession of official media accreditation. Photography is permitted for private purposes only. Violations (apart from those with legitimate media accreditation) will result in prosecution. By attending the event, spectators consent to appearing in any sound or video recordings that may produced and published in association with the event.
- 8.) **Environmental Protection:** Any damage to, or contamination of the event area or the facilities must be avoided. Expressly forbidden in the event venue: the ripping or cutting off of twigs or branches, damaging, fouling or displacing any objects, intentional spillage of water or any other liquids, igniting fires rockets and fireworks. Paper, food scraps, polystyrene and similar materials, as well as refuse of all kinds, must be deposited in the refuse bins provided. It is forbidden to bring environmentally harmful materials such as polystyrene, etc., including exceptionally loud noise generators to the event.
- 9.) **Event Grounds Security:** Instructions received from stewards and security staff intended to maintain order and safety must be obeyed immediately. Persons that fail to comply with the GCA must provide proof of identity. Failure to comply with the GCA or misuse of admission permits will not be tolerated and will result in loss of validity of event access authorization, as well as expulsion from the event grounds.
- 10.) **Liability:** The event Organizer declines all liability for damages incurred by visitors either before, during or after the event and in direct or indirect connection with the event, with the exception of such damages for which compensation may not be excluded. Any infringements of these access regulations may lead to prosecution.
