General Rules and Regulations for Media Accreditation 2022

0. COVID-19

Due to the constantly evolving virus pandemic, the following points should only be considered as basic rules. Necessary adaptations are subject to change. The number of accreditations granted to media representatives are limited, decided only by the Organizer.

1. REGISTRATION

Media accreditation requests will be accepted **until 10th of December 2021**. Late registration is subject to special approval by the Hahnenkamm Race (HKR) Organizers. Special requests with regards to technical equipment must be made at the Press Centre in good time. (See accreditation form **Point "H"** Media Centre <press working area> & **Point "J"** remarks).

2. REQUIREMENTS

Accreditation requires a valid press pass, a credible intent to report from and on the sports event, as well as representation of a major media organization. Press Office Management reserves the right to make restrictions or exceptions. The final decision regarding accreditation rests with the Hahnenkamm-Race Organizers. In case of doubt, confirmation from the respective editor-in-chief will be required by the Organizing Committee.

TV / FILM / RADIO / VIDEO in particular are subject to a separate contractual agreement.

3. ACCREDITATION PASS

The official accreditation pass for the Hahnenkamm Races entitles bearers to access the race site and designated areas (coded according to accreditation pass). These passes are not transferable and must be shown without fail to enforcement officers within the control zones. Compliance with instructions issued by the enforcement officers is compulsory. Pass bearers are subject to the conditions and regulations of FIS Competition Rules and FIS World Cup Regulations, as well as the **Organizer's Rules of Access**. Persons granted special "PISTE" accreditation shall comply with all FIS piste guidelines and instructions given by the Jury and their official representatives without delay. The number of piste accreditations for photo and TV are limited and subject to approval by the FIS Chief Race Director.

4. SPECIAL NOTE

Drones are strictly forbidden!

5. LEGAL NOTICE – TEXT & PHOTOS

Photos and texts of the event may be published through the accredited medium | media representative in print and/or on the Internet or any other digital media services (only for editorial contributions).

Images (photos) may only be passed on for editorial contributions. The resale to third parties for advertising purposes is forbidden or must be clarified with the Organizer.

6. LEGAL NOTICE – MOVING PICTURES & SOUND

Production, transmission and circulation of moving pictures and/or sound via the Internet and other media, both live and delayed, as a whole or parts thereof, are not permitted within the entire event area, regardless of the device (film camera, mobile phone, audio recording device, digital camera, camera, notebook, etc.) or the technical procedure.

Exceptions to this regulation are only admissible with written consent from the Organizer and its rights holders. The contact person for television, film and radio rights is Mr. Andreas Eichwalder (andy@eichwalder.media or +43 664 5005 003). Separate regulations must be observed. Access to the event area only with camera stickers and TV armband which are available at the accreditation counter.

7. SANCTIONS

Failure to comply with the rules and regulations for media accreditation will result in the immediate withdrawal of accreditation. Further sanctions, such as a ban for the following Hahnenkamm Race (accreditation) or legal action is reserved by the Organizer or its partners. The Jury reserves the right to impose additional sanctions pursuant to the ICR.
